The heraldry of the Davidsons has been influenced by maritime contact with the peoples of north-west Europe. The Davidsons, originally from Scotland, used heraldic designs and motifs which have origins from this area. The merchants of the Scottish east coast ports of Aberdeen, Dundee, Perth, Culross and Leith were trading with the Scandinavian, Baltic and North Sea ports from the 13th century onwards as part of the Hanseatic League. Later Scotland established its own staple port at Veere in south-west Holland by treaty.
