Azure, on a Fess between three pheons Argent, a stag couchant Gules atyred with ten tyned Or

Crest: A falcon's head, coupéd Proper

Motto: Viget In Cincere Virtus



This inscribed stone bearing the Balgay Arms was found during the 1970s excavation of the site of a house in the centre of Perth. It has been cleaned and painted, and reinstalled in a stair well inside the Marks & Spencer store now located on this site.

1672-1678 Member of Parliament.

Robert Davidson's father was MP for Dundee, who died 1651 defending Dundee during an English attack.
