This petition is the first from an Australian family all of whom are descended from a William Davidson, born 1835, a blacksmith from Alva in Clackmannan-shire in Scotland. William was a son John Davidson from Crail and grandson of John Davidson from St Andrews.

The arms are Argent, on a fess Azure between two pheons Gules in chief and a thistle slipped Purpure in base and in centre chief a caltrap of the Third, a stag lodged Or. For crest a stag's head erased Proper charged on a neck with a caltrap Argent.
